
CONTINUED ON REVERSE

WHAT KIND OF A TEMPORARY SIGN CAN I HAVE?

The code permits:

- A banner (mounted to a wall or ground mounted with at least 2 supports); or
- A yard sign







Other signs and attention-getting devices are not permitted.









APPLICANT ACCEPTANCE

I hereby certify that the information contained in this application and accompanying plans is correct, and that I will conform to all applicable laws of the City of Maryland Heights. I also understand that it is my responsibility to make sure that I comply with all individual subdivision indentures. I further certify that I have read and understand the following:

- 1. The temporary sign must be placed on the subject property and not within the right-of-way of the street (signs in the lawn between the sidewalk and street are prohibited).
- 2. The temporary sign must be located at least 2 feet from any property line.
- 3. The temporary sign cannot interfere with pedestrian or vehicle movement, sight or safety.
- 4. Signs shall be securely fastened or mounted at all times.
- 5. On a multi-tenant property, banners must be a minimum distance of 200 feet apart and yard signs must be a minimum of 100 feet apart from each other and from banners.
